Power of Free Will & Skill of Choices:

Provide students with *2 positive choices* of things that they can do and you are totally okay with them doing. Let go of the control and let them use their free will to choose between the 2 choices.

but you may not _____. Which works best for you?”

Helpful Tips:

For kids who are hesitant to make a choice, help guide them to a decision.
For kids who refuse to make a choice, choose for them and move on.
For kids who change their mind after the fact, remind them of their choice and stick to it.
