PBIS Student Recognition

Overview: At Disney, we use the Ron Clarke House System to encourage positive behavior. With this, we have 4 Pods. Each grade level is represented in each Pod to create a sense of community through the Pod System.

I DId It Tickets: Students are given I Did It Tickets for individual recognition. The phrase, "You Did It" is frequently, consistently, and intentionally used by staff to get students in the mind set that they took responsibility for their own actions and they were mindful of their own emotions. Each ticket is worth 1 point in the house system.

Dolphin Dots: Dolphin Dots are given by any adult in the building as a whole class reward.

Dolphin Dot Charts: Dolphin Dot stickers are collected on charts. When a chart is full (50 stickers) they are turned into their Pod bucket for 50 points and the class may vote on a celebration of their choice.

Specials Tickets: Specials teachers give classes a score for behavior during their special classes each week. The scores correlate with Pod points and get turned in towards the quarterly goal.

The Prize Drop: In the diner, students are picked to spin the wheel of fun for exhibiting Dolphin Best Behavior. With this, they earn points for the Pod.

POD Party: Each quarter, the Pod with the most points earns a Pod Party. The party consists of an inflatable, a snack, and several game rotations.

Monthly Rally: A celebratory monthly rally is held to honor students (2 per class) for exhibiting exemplary character for the past month. Families and friends are invited as well as the entire student body joins in on the fun and celebrations in the diner.
