We are aware that many families are currently without internet access and we have you all on waiting lists for district provided Kajeet hotspots. We are unsure of the timeline on receiving these devices. However, I want to share the following resources your family may be able to use at this time. The following companies are offering free or reduced fee internet services based on income and family circumstances.

At&T: Includes free installation, free in home Wi-Fi and a data allowance of 150GB or 1TB depending on speed available in your area. \$10 charge for each additional 50GB.In response to the public health crisis, Access from AT&T is temporarily: Offering two months of free service to new customers who order Access by April 30, 2020. \$5/mo or \$10/mo thereafter, depending on your speed. Expanding eligibility based on income2 and to households participating in the National School Lunch Program/Head Start. Waiving all home internet data overage fees. Suddenlink: Suddenlink is offering free internet for 60 days to families in specific income brackets, but it requires a \$20 set up fee. Call 877-694-9474 for more information.
