

Congratulations to our Phelps MOEMS Team on our Contest # 1 on Tuesday, November 19, 2019! Each of our 23 team members worked to solve 5 MOEMS problems in 30 minutes. We are delighted that our fourth, fifth and sixth grade mathletes earned 61 team points. We are so proud of every team member for staying focused throughout Contest #1 and working so hard to do their very best.

Two 5th grade mathletes scored a Perfect 5 of 5.

Five mathletes scored a 4 of 5. Five mathletes scored 3 of 5. Five mathetes scored 2 of 5. Six members Everyone team member who competed scored at least on point for our team. Following Contest #1 we reviewed the answers and methods to solve each problem.

Due to MOEMS copyright, we are not able to share the problems, but basically 18 of our 23 team members (78%) earned a point on the first problem, 11 of 23 team members (48%) earned a point on the second problem. 12 of 23 team members (52%) earned a point on the third problem, 13 of 23 team members (57%) earned a point on the fourth problem, and 7 of 23 team members (30%) earned a point on the fifth problem. Generally, the first problem is easier than the fifth problem. You may discuss the problems with your child.

We will continue working on MOEMS type problems during Contest Math class each week at WINGS.
