2022 NAACP YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP

Eligibility Requirements

- 1. Must be a graduating minority high school student.
- 2. Must be pursuing an undergraduate degree at an established college, university, or vocational school. Other specialized training or certification may be considered and approved by the NAACP.

Applications:

- 1. All applications delivered in person must be received NAACP by April 15th, 2022. If mailed, applications must be postmarked no later than April 15, 2022.
- 2. In addition to the application, required materials include:
 - An official transcript
 - A brief statement (<500 words) that describes
 - Your advocacy/activism work to date (Do not simply list organizations you belong to; tell what you were trying to accomplish, what you did, and what you learned from the experience)
 - Your educational plan
 - Two letters of recommendation from teachers, school administrators or community leaders who know you well.
- 3. Incomplete applications will not be processed.

Selection criteria:

- 1. Selection for the scholarship is based on the following criteria:
 - Demonstrated advocacy or activism in the community. Preference is given to students who have been active in the NAACP-Springfield Branch Youth Chapter.
 - Academic achievement
 - Work experience
 - Ability to write well
 - Community service and volunteering

Award:

- 1. The recipient of the scholarship will be notified by a member of the NAACP scholarship committee.
- 2. Upon acceptance of admission and attendance into the selected school, the NAACP will issue a one-time check for the 2022-2023 academic year.
