Internet Hotspot Information and Application for Families Without Internet Access at Home

“Access for All”

What is “Access for All”? Access for All provides internet access via mobile hotspots. These hotspots allow Springfield Public School students access to educational resources remotely anywhere.

Who can apply? Springfield Public School students who DO NOT have internet access at home may apply.

What is the approval process for “Access for All”? Hotspots are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Applicants must complete the application and return it to the school library. Approval will be based on availability and demonstrated need.

Important Information, Terms, and Conditions:

- Hotspots have unlimited data. Hotspots with consistently low usage will be recalled so another student may be provided with access.
- Hotspots are filtered for educational use ONLY.
- Hotspot usage is monitored to ensure it is being used appropriately. Students demonstrating usage for inappropriate content will be required to return the device.
- If home internet access is gained, the hotspot should be returned as soon as possible so another student may be provided with access.
- Loss of the hotspot will result in a \$50 charge to the student’s account.
