Snow is cold, that is very well known. Snow can chill you right to the bone!

TYLER

Snow can make you shake and quiver.

SPEAKER 10:

When I get cold, all I do is shiver!

SONG 2: (B-R-R-R! THE SHIVER SONG)

All this shivering has me in a tizzy.

KAYLEE

SPEAKER 12: If you don't want to be cold, you have to stay busy!

MAKLYN

SPEAKER 13: That's right! If you keep on moving along, You won't have to sing the same

FAITH

BASH

(Ronaesha, Stella, Olivia, River, Cyrus, Alaina, Mason, Allison, Timmy)

SCENE 4 – 3rd grade Meinhardt

SPEAKER 24: Ladies and gents, since the driveway is now clear,

FABIAN

SPEAKER 25:

DAZIRA

Let's give our next act a great big cheer!

(SERENITY whispers in Caiden's ear)

SPEAKER 26: It seems we have a slight delay.

CAIDEN

The reason why is one of our next performers is a little bit shy!

SPEAKER 27: EVALEE

SPEAKER 28: He wants to perform but there is a little twist,

JANE

Some of you don't even believe he exists.

SPEAKER 29: TAEVIN

SPEAKER 30:

Maybe if you would clap real loud,

ELLIE

SPEAKER 31: He'd hear that you are a believing crowd.

LANE

ALL: (Clapping with audience)

SPEAKER 32:

Well that wasn't bad and you all did your best,

MERCY

SPEAKER 33:

ANNA

But maybe some cheering would help our next guest.

ALL: (Clapping and cheering)

(SERENITY whispers in Finley's ear)

SPEAKER 34:

FINLEY

He says he's ready. Your cheering did the trick.

SPEAKER 35: LANDON So, let's introduce him, and get him on quick!

SPEAKER 36:

Ladies and gentlemen!

MAX

Please put your mittens together for our next guest.

SPEAKER 37:

ELLIOTT

The Abominable Snowman is the absolute best!

(SNOWMAN enters to cheers)

SNOWMAN:

Thank you! Thank you very much!

NOAH

It's a pleasure to be here.

We have so much to show, so much for you to watch. Please welcome my friends, Bigfoot and Sasquatch!

(SASQUATCH and BIG FOOT enter to applause)

SASQUATCH:

MADDOX

Sasquatch is my name. Being here is a treat.

BIG FOOT:

You'll recognize me by the size of my feet! (Holds up one foot at a time)

NATE

SASQUATCH:

No need to be afraid. No need to worry.

MADDOX

BIG FOOT:

No need to fear us just because we are furry!

NATE

SONG 4: SNOW BUDDIES

SNOWMAN: (singing)The three of us have been pals forever.

NOAH

SASQUATCH: (singing) I'm the charmer...

MADDOX

BIG FOOT: (singing) And I'm very clever!

NATE

SNOWMAN: (singing) One thing we know is whatever the weather,

NOAH

SASQUATCH: (singing) Come blizzard, or not...

MADDOX

BIG FOOT: (singing) Good friends stick together.

NATE

(The three put their arms over each other's shoulders as they sing and sway with all of the students on the risers)

SNOWMAN, SASQUATCH, BIG FOOT: We're Snow Buddies!

SAGE heart.

ABIGAIL you all go!
