YOLUNTEER BOATER INFORMATION

INSURANCE

*Volunteer boaters are required to carry at least \$100,000 of boater/personal liability insurance.

BACKGROUND CHECK

*All owner/volunteer boaters must complete a District volunteer background check through Springfield Public Schools. These must be kept on file in the site Athletic Directors office in the high school office.

BOAT USADE FOR PRACTICE

- *SPS lighting policy must be followed.
- *All boats must meet coast guard requirements.

BOAT USAGE FOR TOURNAMENTS

- *SPS lighting policy must be followed.
- *Boat with stick steering, houseboats, barges and other cumbersome craft will not be allowed.
- *Boats must have a properly aerated live well.
- *All boats must be equipped with an engine shut-off device securely attached to the boat operator "kill switch" when the combustion engine is running.
- *Anglers are NOT allowed to use or operate the combustion engine for fishing purposes at any time during the event. High school anglers CAN only operate the electric trolling motor.
- *Volunteer boaters cannot volunteer information regarding fishing locations.
- *Volunteer boaters cannot give instruction on baits or locations to any High School Angler.
- *Contestants are not allowed to stand in any vessel that is on plane at any time during competition.
