

Pandemic Food Stamp/Supplemental Nutritional Assistance Program (P-SNAP)

Frequently Asked Questions

What is P-SNAP?

Pandemic Food Stamp/Supplemental Nutritional Assistance Program (P-SNAP) will allow all households currently eligible for SNAP to receive the **maximum amount** for their household size for March and April.

Who can get P-SNAP?

Anyone who is currently eligible for SNAP will automatically receive P-SNAP.

How much should my food stamp benefit be with P-SNAP?

You benefit will be the maximum amount depending on your household size. To see the maximum amount for your household, please refer to our **[food stamp benefits chart](#)**.

How do I get P-SNAP?

You do not need to do anything to get P-SNAP. This benefit will be loaded to your EBT card automatically.

When will P-SNAP be available?

Households will receive P-SNAP for March and April:

- Your March P-SNAP benefit will be loaded to your card automatically by April 3
- Your April P-SNAP benefit will be automatically loaded to your card on the day you normally receive your SNAP benefit

What should I do if I do not get my P-SNAP benefit by the dates listed above?

When will P-SNAP benefits end?

We do not know at this time if P-SNAP benefits will continue after April. Continue to check back for updates.

Pandemic EBT (Electronic Benefit Transfer) (P-EBT)

Frequently Asked Questions

What is P-EBT?

Pandemic EBT (P-EBT) is a temporary SNAP benefit available while schools are closed for households with children who receive free and reduced lunch at school.

Who can get help through P-EBT?

This benefit is available to all Missouri families with children who are:

- Eligible for free and reduced price lunch in a Missouri school district
- Currently unable to attend school for 5 consecutive days due to school closure

How do I get P-EBT?

If you already receive SNAP benefits, P-EBT will be loaded onto your EBT card automatically as soon as it is approved.

If you do not receive SNAP benefits, you will need to apply for P-EBT through a special application process. We will provide this application and more details as soon as it is available and approved.

When will P-EBT benefits be available?

We do not know when P-EBT benefits will be available at this time, but we will provide updates as soon as possible. Continue to check this site for additional information.
