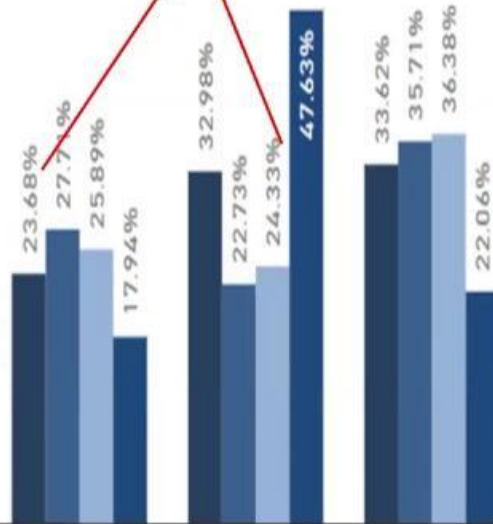

These areas should be decreasing

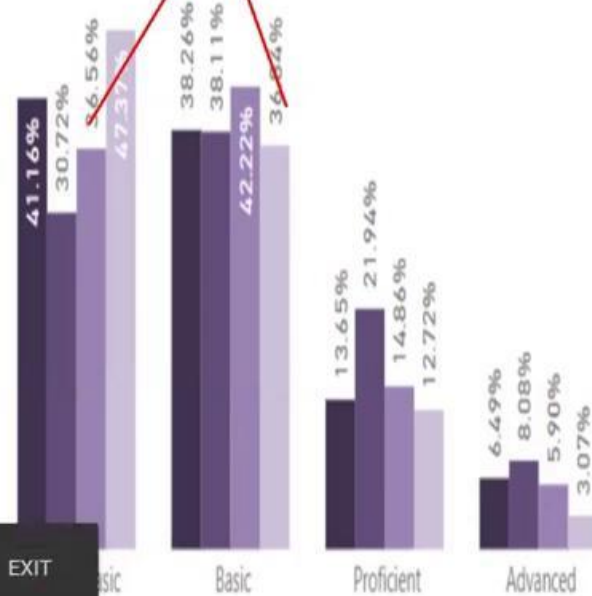

These areas should be decreasing

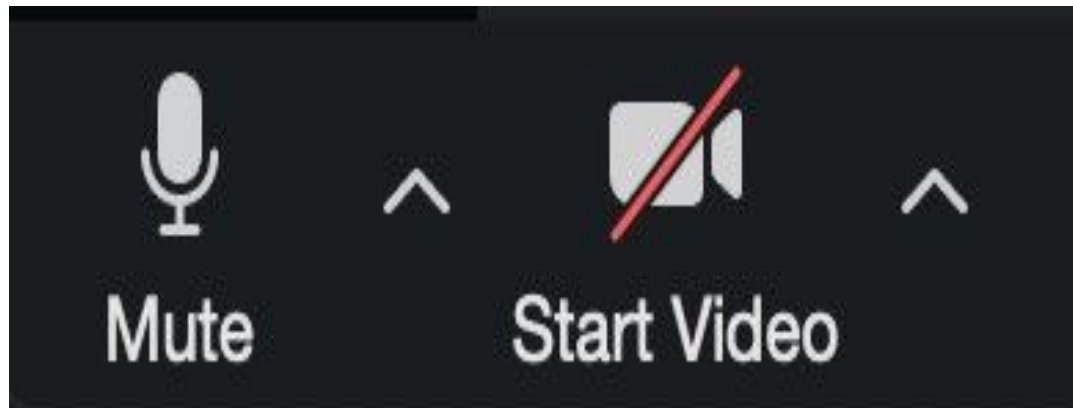

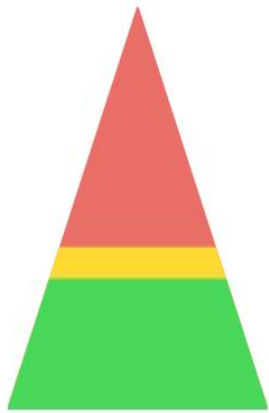

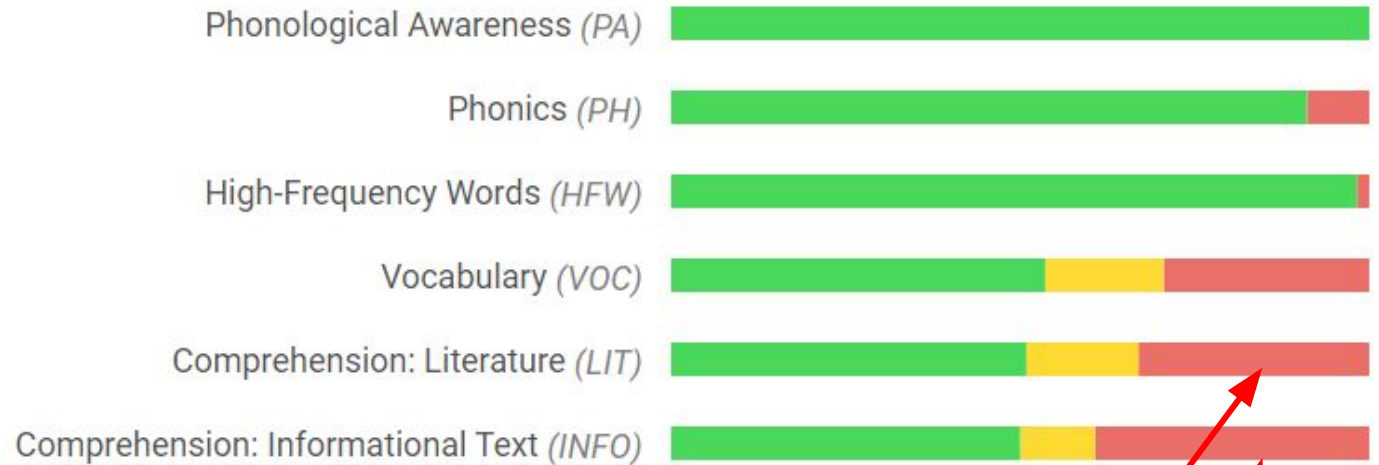

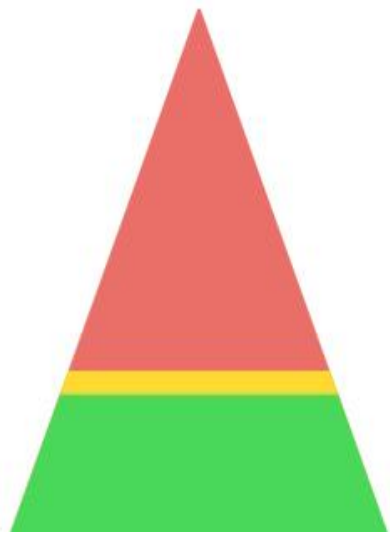

eSchoolPLUS+ Home Access Center

Dear Parents and Guardians:

It is with great excitement that Springfield R-12 Public Schools has completed their conversion to our new student information system and the new Home Access Center (HAC) web portal for parents. You may obtain your secure access from your school site with proper identification. Once you have received your Home Access Center user name and password you will be able to access your student's registration information, attendance, assignment and grade information.

Please allow teachers adequate time to enter your student's grade, assignments and long-term project information.



The Home Access Center Login screen shown at <https://spshomeaccess.sps.k12.mo.us/homeaccess/> allows a parent/student to enter their **Username** and **Password** that was generated by the system to access a student's registration, attendance, assignment and grade information. The username and password are not case sensitive and do not require the capital letters to be entered that may be shown on the user registration form.
