General Information for All Families

• NEW SPS Cell Phone Policy: SPS is enforcing a new cell phone/electronic device policy for the 2025-2026 school year. State law now prohibits students from using or displaying any personal electronic communication devices during the school day.

- This includes, but is not limited to, cell phones, smartwatches, headphones, wireless earbuds, or any similar device capable of initiating, receiving, storing, or viewing communication, information, images, or data electronically.
- Devices must be turned off and stored out of sight from 8:10 a.m. to 3:10 p.m.
- Phones are prohibited on campus (Including instructional time, lunch, time between classes, and Hornet Time).
- Students who violate the policy will be required to store their phones in the office until the end of the school day and will face consequences outlined in the <u>SPS Student Handbook</u> (p. 59).

- Free/Reduced Lunch Application: Apply at sps.org/Page/2400
- <u>Breakfast/Lunch:</u> Breakfast is free. Students may grab breakfast at a kiosk and report to class each day. If your student chooses to eat <u>school lunch</u>, you may add money to their account at: <u>www.mypaymentsplus.com/welcome</u>
- <u>Food Deliveries</u>: Students may NOT use food delivery services. If food is delivered, delivery drivers will be turned away at the student's expense. Parents MAY bring food to students, but they will not be called out of class for parent food deliveries.
- <u>Drop-Off/Pick-Up Procedures</u>: Use the **Grant Avenue entrance** for student drop-off/pick-up at the main entrance (two-lane system). Buses will use the **north lot**. Do not drop off/pick up in the **north lot** or **staff parking lot**. School opens to students at **7:40 a.m.**.
- Transportation: Register for bus transportation at <u>connect.sps.org</u> or call (417) 523-0500
- Student Handbook: You can find the 25-26 Student Handbook on the SPS website under Parents & Guardians Resources.
- <u>Student Devices</u>: Chromebooks will be distributed in the library at the start of the school year. Lost or damaged devices will be charged to the student's account.
- <u>Financial Info</u>: Pay fines, purchase parking permits, and activity passes through **Mrs. Drake** in the finance office or online via <u>MvSchoolBucks</u>. Student Parking Permits are \$35 for the year. Tickets will be issued for unregistered vehicles.
- <u>Dance Eligibility</u>: Students must meet attendance and behavior standards. Details at: <u>SPS Dance Policy</u>
- <u>Final Exam Exemptions</u>: Students meeting academic, attendance, and behavior expectations may be exempt from end-of-semester finals. Details at: Final Exam Exemptions

- Athletic & Activity Fees
 - Athletic Fee: \$50 (waived if student qualifies for free/reduced lunch)
 - Student Activity Pass: \$10 (ID badge will be marked for SPS game access)
 - Patron Activity Pass: \$50/year or \$25/semester
 - Student ID required for entry into all SPS high school football games.

PAPERWORK REQUIREMENTS: ALL sports physicals and annual requirement forms will be submitted online through **Final Forms**: https://springfield-mo.finalforms.com/.

To create an account, go to <u>Final Forms</u>, click on Parent Login, and then select "Never Logged in?" Enter the email address you have on file with SPS.

You will receive an email asking you to create an account. Once you log in to your account, you can update all information for your student(s).

Any student needing an updated sports physical can pick one up in the main office or <u>print one from our website</u>.
