

Central High School Dance Rules

- Students must attend all classes the day of the dance. Any unavoidable absences must be preapproved by an administrator. Students will be checked in to the event and compared to an attendance list generated at the school. SRO and administration will observe students as they enter looking for contraband and possible impairments.
- Disciplinary actions that occur which cause suspensions (ISS or OSS) prior to and over the date of the dance will eliminate that student from participation.
- Student behavior expectations and regular codes of conduct, and all student handbook policies are in effect, and will be enforced, at all school dances/events.
 - Traditional dress and appropriate attire is expected; though allowances are made due to the uniqueness of formal attire (dresses).
- Students and their dates may be asked to leave the dance if necessary without refund.
- Guests must be approved in advance by completing an information sheet. This sheet includes information on the guest, signature by home school administrator (if appropriate), and approval signature by the site school administrator. Tickets cannot be purchased for the guest without this document. Non-school guests must at least be in the 9th grade and are less than 21 years of age. You can pick up this document in the attendance office with Mrs. Hardy **TWO WEEKS PRIOR** to the dance.
- All students purchasing dance tickets must pay outstanding debts **OVER \$20** prior to purchasing a ticket. Anything under \$20 is permissible.
- Tickets are non-transferable and non-refundable and will be checked against a sales list.
- If a student or guest leaves the dance, they may not return.
- Due to attendance expectations, students who utilize a college visit on the day of a dance will not be allowed to attend that dance.
