HELP, PLEASE! **The bus lane/office area is neither a morning drop-off point nor a pick-up point after school.** The circle drive is only for the buses and daycare vans to use. Please note that delayed bus information is posted on the district Facebook and homepage. For student safety, and the need to have appropriate supervisory staff on site, students are to be dropped off at school **no earlier than 8:20 (30 minutes prior to school starting)** unless they are enrolled in Prime Time. If your child is arriving after 9:05, **you must walk in with them to sign them in for class.** Please do **NOT** just send them in alone! Also, when inclement weather is forecasted, **please plan ahead and leave early** in order to arrive to school safely, and on time. Thanks for your cooperation.



Brrr – Be sure to dress in layers during cold weather! And, please remember when planning vacations, each “snow day” adds a day to the end of the school calendar (up to six days).
